Ray A. Booton



The Kappa Foundation of Charlotte is seeking your support in honoring our Elder Watson Diggs Awardee, Ray A. Booton, while helping to continue the uplift of our local youth through the Kappa Foundation.

The Ray A. Booton Golf Classic is a major fundraiser supporting the foundation's programs including scholarships to deserving students who are pursuing a college education.

The Kappa Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization whose primary purpose is to assist with furthering the education of Charlotte area high school students who will be enrolling into a four year or two year institution of higher learning and further provide scholarships to students currently enrolled in a four year institution of higher learning in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Notables of Ray A. Booton include:

- One of the first African American police officers in Charlotte, NC. Served the community until 1949.
- Inducted into the National Black Golf Hall of Fame in 1999
- One of 13 to sign a petition that eventually lead to litigation against the City of Charlotte, resulting in successfully integrating the City's Bonnie Rae Golf Course (now Revolution Golf Course)
- Played the course regularly with golf greats like Charlie Sifford and James Black, who both eventually played on the PGA Tour
- First African American golfer to fire a hole-in-one on the 8th hole at Hillcrest Golf Course, (formerly Meadowbrook Golf Course)
- Won six amateur tournaments and has numerous top five finishes. Has over thirty trophies dating from 1948 to 1988.
- In 1957, long before the course ended its all white policy, Booton watched The Masters golf tournament at Augusta National from a house on the 10th hole with President Dwight Eisenhower
- Worked with The U.S. Postal Service as supervisor and regional hearing officer / investigator for 16 years
- Served the Presbyterian Church as ordained minister from 1963 through 1984
